<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handwashing and general hygiene • Name different foods and help a grown up Cook a healthy meal • Play a game – it is ok to lose • Do daily exercise – try some yoga • Mindful colouring • Sing and dance to your favourite songs! This makes you feel great! • Learn to ride your bike/scooter 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw what you can see out of your window • Make a sound story using body percussion and household items (e.g. represent rain, create a soundtrack/effects for a story) • Create and perform a puppet show for your family (using made puppets, toys etc) • Create a picture (art attack style) using household items – take a photograph! • Draw and colour your favourite things 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a picture of any room in your house and try to label it. • Traffic count from the window (set a time, compare different times of the day) • Look at family photos and talk about the past • Talk about their own personal history – What can they do now that they couldn't before? What do they want to do in the future? • Draw your family tree and talk about different relatives that live away from Newport in other towns, cities and countries.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose a cuddly toy/doll to share a book with everyday • Find letters and words around the house (newspapers, instructions) • Practice writing your first name and surname and letter formation • Play eye spy with my little eye • Make collections of rhyming words • Find objects in the house that begin with 's' etc... • Keep a diary drawing what you do/learn each day and try and write about this • Learn to read some new words (see the list of keywords and make flashcards) • Learn to spell some new words (CVC words such as, 'cup, peg' and see the list of keywords) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to count forwards and backwards in steps of 1 (1-10) • Practice reading and writing numbers 1-10 • Represent numbers using pictures and objects – Draw 5, find 6 etc • Find 2D and 3D shapes around the home • Make collections of small household items and count these • Order household items according to size, weight, length etc (use comparative language) • Create a repeating pattern • Matching - pair up socks, numbers, dot patterns etc 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognise and name the main body parts • Explore the 5 sense of taste, sight, touch, hearing and smell – What is your favourite sound? Least favourite sound? • Explore your garden – What birds/animals/plants do you see? • Help prepare and cook food • Make a model of your house using junk/lego • Keep a weather journal in welsh too! • Sort a selection of objects – what it is made of (wood, plastic etc), properties (soft, hard etc)
