<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Handwashing and general hygiene</li> <li>• Cook a healthy meal</li> <li>• Play a game – it is ok to lose</li> <li>• Do daily exercise – try some yoga</li> <li>• Mindful colouring</li> <li>• Sing and dance to your favourite songs! This makes you feel great!</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw what you can see out of your window</li> <li>• Make a sound story using body percussion and household items (e.g. represent rain, create a soundtrack/effects for a story)</li> <li>• Create and perform a puppet show for your family (using made puppets, toys etc)</li> <li>• Create a picture (art attack style) using household items – take a photograph!</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw a map/plan of any room in your house or the whole house</li> <li>• Traffic count from the window (set a time, compare different times of the day, tally, bar graph etc)</li> <li>• Interview your family about their childhood (toys, school, technology, food etc)</li> <li>• Look at family photos and talk about the past</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Choose a cuddly toy/doll to read to everyday</li> <li>• Write a simple book review (My favourite book is ... because...)</li> <li>• Keep a diary drawing and writing what you do/learn each day</li> <li>• Learn to read a new word everyday (see the list of keywords and make flashcards)</li> <li>• Learn to spell a new word everyday (see the list of keywords)</li> <li>• Complete a piece of writing to accompany tasks on this sheet (e.g. instructions about how to make a model, a puppet show script, label drawings etc)</li> <li>• Retell simple stories you have read (verbally and in writing)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue to count forwards in steps of 1, 2, 5 and 10 – Count backwards in steps of 1</li> <li>• Find 2D and 3D shapes around the home</li> <li>• Make collections of small household items and count these (make estimations first, group them in tens etc)</li> <li>• Order household items according to size, weight, length etc (use comparative language, use non-standard and standard measures)</li> <li>• Learn to read the time on an analogue and digital clock (o'clock and half past)</li> <li>• Pair up socks and practice counting in 2s</li> <li>• Set up a shop using household goods and role play paying for items and giving change using real money</li> <li>• Find numbers around the house (food packaging, page numbers, remote control)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explore different household items               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– What is it made of?</li> <li>– What properties does it have? (waterproof, shiny, transparent etc)</li> <li>– Does it float/change shape etc?</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Explore your garden – What birds/animals/plants do you see?</li> <li>• Help prepare and cook food</li> <li>• Make a model of your house using junk/lego</li> <li>• Keep a weather journal</li> <li>• Draw and label a picture of yourself – (parts of the body)</li> <li>• Explore the 5 sense of taste, sight, touch, hearing and smell – What is your favourite sound? Least favourite sound?</li> </ul>
