 Choose a cuddly toy/doll to read to everyday Write a simple book review (My favourite book is because) Keep a diary drawing and writing what you do/learn each day Learn to read a new word everyday (see the list of keywords and make flashcards) Learn to spell a new word everyday (see the list of keywords) Complete a piece of writing to accompany tasks on this sheet (e.g. instructions about how to make a model, a puppet show script, label drawings etc) Retell simple stories you have read (verbally and in writing) 	 Continue to count forwards in steps of 1, 2, 5 and 10 – Count backwards in steps of 1 Find 2D and 3D shapes around the home Make collections of small household items and count these (make estimations first, group them in tens etc) Order household items according to size, weight, length etc (use comparative language, use non-standard and standard measures) Learn to read the time on an analogue and digital clock (o'clock and half past) Pair up socks and practice counting in 2s Set up a shop using household goods and role play paying for items and giving change using real money Find numbers around the house (food packaging, page numbers, remote control) 	 Explore different household items What is it made of? What properties does it have? (waterproof, shiny, transparent etc) Does it float/change shape etc? Explore your garden – What birds/animals/plants do you see? Help prepare and cook food Make a model of your house using junk/lego Keep a weather journal Draw and label a picture of yourself – (parts of the body) Explore the 5 sense of taste, sight, touch, hearing and smell – What is your favourite sound? Least favourite sound?
